A. INTRODUCTION

Brunei Darussalam, with its vast network of rivers, mangroves, and wetlands, provides a natural habitat for the estuarine crocodile (Crocodylus porosus), one of the most iconic and ecologically significant species in the region. Over the years, the growing interactions between humans and crocodiles have highlighted the need for a comprehensive approach to manage this species effectively, ensuring both conservation and community safety. Several initiatives have been done to mitigate and prevent human and crocodile conflicts which in includes catching and relocating operations and awareness programs. Now to capitalize on this remarkable creature, Brunei Darussalam is seeking investors to invest, develop, operate and manage crocodile rescues estate in Brunei Darussalam in a 30 hectares land located Tutong District with basic infrastructure such as access road, water supply, electrical power station provided by the government. The estate is aim to create controlled environments for crocodile that had been rescued and breed, the plan will reduce pressure on wild populations, mitigate human-crocodile conflicts, and support local economic growth through the legal trade of high-value crocodile products such as leather and meat. This effort is guided by principles of sustainability and compliance with international conservation standards, such as the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES). Beyond economic benefits, the plan envisions fostering public awareness, supporting scientific research, and promoting ecotourism to showcase Brunei's commitment to environmental stewardship. Through this management plan, Brunei Darussalam is not only addressing local conservation challenges but also setting a precedent for sustainable wildlife resource utilization, ensuring that crocodile farming becomes a model of ecological and economic sustainability.

B. OBJECTIVES

- To invest, develop, operate and manage a crocodile rescue estate that complies international conservation standards, namely the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES).
- To have a balance in the ecological significance of crocodiles with their potential economic benefits.

C. SCOPE OF WORK

i. Estate Design and Infrastructure Development

- Design and build enclosures that simulate natural habitats and meet the needs of different life stages of crocodiles that complies with international standards (CITES).
- Develop water management systems to maintain clean and regulated aquatic environments.
- Establish support facilities, including incubation centers, feed storage, processing units, and administrative offices that complies with international standards (CITES).
- Incorporate safety measures to minimize risks to farm workers and nearby communities.

ii. Operational Framework

- Develop feeding schedules and dietary plans to optimize crocodile health and growth.
- Establish health monitoring and veterinary care systems to prevent and manage diseases.
- Create waste management systems to handle organic waste and minimize environmental impact.
